Here is a structured 90-day preparation plan for SSC CHT Paper-I (General Hindi & General English), designed to help you build strong fundamentals, ensure regular practice, and gain exam confidence: Note: You need to focus on the second paper along with the first one for the exam.

### **Preparation Phases Overview**

PHASE	DAYS	FOCUS AREAS
PHASE - I	1-30 days	Foundation - Hindi/English Grammar & Vocabulary
PHASE - II	31 - 60 days	Practice - Topic-wise MCQs + RC
PHASE - III	61 - 90 days	Full Mocks + Revision + Weak Area Focus

## Phase 1: Build the Basics (Days 1–30)

Goal: Strengthen grammar concepts, vocabulary, and start light practice.

### Daily Routine (Minimum Time to be spent)

- 2 hours Hindi Grammar + MCQs (Only in case of being good at Hindi)
- 3 hours English Grammar + Vocabulary
- 1 hour Practice on Translation & Essay (bilingual)

### Focus Areas:

- Hindi: संधि, समास, वाक्य शुद्धि, काल, लिंग, कारक
- English: Tenses, Prepositions, Articles, Subject-Verb Agreement, Voice & Narration
- Vocabulary: 30 words daily (both languages)





# Weekly Tasks:

- 2 RC (1 Hindi, 1 English)
- 1 Mini Quiz (20-25 questions chapter-wise from each subject)
- Practice of at least one Hindi and English Translation Passage and one Essay Preparation (Bilingual)

# Phase 2: Practice Intensive (Days 31–60)

Goal: Improve accuracy & speed through topic-wise practice and start your mock tests.

## Daily Routine (Minimum Time spent):

- 1 hr. Hindi Topic-wise/Section-wise MCQs
- 2 hrs. English Topic-wise/Section-wise MCQs
- 1 hr. Vocabulary + Idioms/Phrases + Translation
- 1 hr. Practice on Translation & Essay (bilingual)

### Focus Areas:

- Error spotting, Cloze tests, Synonyms/Antonyms, Comprehension-based questions (Bilingual)
- Hindi-English translation practice and covering at least one essay topic
- Comprehension-based Questions in both languages, including newspaper reading

## Weekly Tasks:

- 1 Full-length mock test and then a thorough analysis
- 1 Essay and 1 Translation Passage (optional)
- Work on weaker areas

## Phase 3: Mock Mode & Revision (Days 61–90)

### Goal: Simulate exam conditions and finalize preparation.

### **Daily Routine:**

- 2 hrs Mock test including previous paper
- 1 hr Error analysis + Doubt resolution
- 1 hr Weak area revision
- 30 mins Vocabulary flashcards + Revision

## Weekly Tasks:

- 2 Full-length Mock Tests
- Revision of Hindi-English grammar rules with short notes, if necessary
